Dear Friends & Family,

We need to let you know of some sad yet exciting changes that are happening in our lives and ministry. Many of you know us personally and have been supporting us for many years, so we think it's important that you hear this news directly from us.

For some time now we have felt led to consider how we can best continue to serve in medical missions. This meant that concerns we have had in our long-term partnership with Global Outreach Mission (GOM) could no longer be ignored. Our desire was to work together in an orderly transition to another mission agency sending and supporting us. We did not intend to immediately sever ties with GOM, but sadly, our references to "transitioning" were misinterpreted.

In spite of our multiple attempts to clarify misunderstandings, and work towards reconciliation and resolution, we were informed that we are no longer with GOM. After we received word from the mission notifying us that we had resigned, we waited some time for a breakthrough, before completing applications to serve with Christian Health Service Corps.

What attracted us to Christian Health Service Corps is the fact that they specialize in sending & supporting healthcare professionals serving overseas long-term. As a ministry of Christian doctors, health professionals, and health educators serving in places where people have little access to healthcare, the Christian Health Service Corps (CHSC) is dedicated to community transformation.

CHSC health professionals provide compassionate health care while increasing knowledge & understanding that builds community capacity for positive sustainable change. CHSC respects human dignity, while promoting a worldview that nurtures and supports spiritual, and physical wholeness in families; ensures child survival and growth; and improves health infrastructure and access to quality healthcare services. It is clear that CHSC really does value equality, humility, servanthood, and stewardship.

It is our joy to announce that as of November 18, we have been accepted and appointed by the Christian Health Service Corps. We have joined the
